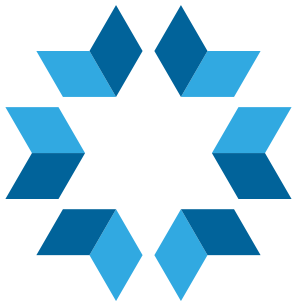
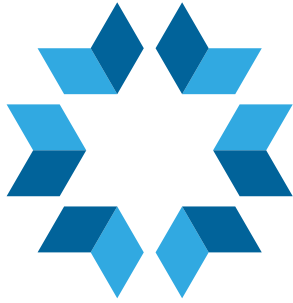

RELIGIOUS SCHOOL

Religious School is the cornerstone of Jewish education for many families, instilling meaningful values and a deep-rooted connection to Judaism in our children. Through our Project-Based Learning curriculum, students develop a strong Jewish identity, guided by spiritual and ethical values.

We emphasize the practical application of teachings, ensuring that Torah study translates into real-life values. Our curriculum includes Hebrew language skills, prayer meaning, and the significance of Jewish heritage, fostering a love for our traditions.

Family Educational Programs and Annual Field Trips enrich our students' experiences, connecting them with Jewish culture beyond the classroom.



GESHER



Now available daily at TKAE from 2:30-4 p.m. or at David Posnack JCC on Tuesday Wednesday, and Thursday from 3-4 p.m.

Hebrew and Israel is the heart of Gesher. It is an after-school program designed for grades K-5. This program offers students the opportunity to learn about Israeli culture firsthand, enabling them to develop a deep love for Israel and a strong understanding of Judaism and Jewish traditions.

Gesher integrates technology, experiential learning, and field trips to create vibrant and engaging educational experiences. The curriculum covers various aspects of Jewish education, including Judaic studies, Torah, holidays, modern Hebrew, prayers, and Israel, with monthly themes that align with the Jewish calendar.

B'NAI & B'NOT MITZVAH TOGETHER



B'NAI

Our Bar Mitzvah Club is a pilot program designed to prepare young men for the responsibilities and meaning of becoming B'nai Mitzvah. This weekly gathering fosters camaraderie and brotherhood among the participants, and includes a trip to NY City.

Throughout the program, students will delve into Jewish traditions, rituals, ethics, and community leadership. Each session aims to deepen their understanding and appreciation of their heritage. The ultimate goal is to empower these young men to become responsible and confident Jewish adults. At the culmination of this program, participants will participate in a ceremony together celebrating the journey.

B'NOT

Our B'not Mitzvah Program offers a weekly gathering for 6th-grade girls, where they learn essential traditions and rituals, preparing them for their upcoming Bat Mitzvahs and includes a trip to NY City.

Throughout this journey, students will explore the role of women in Judaism and discover the beauty of our rituals and traditions through a series of weekly sessions. Each session aims to deepen their understanding and appreciation of their heritage. At the culmination of this program, participants will celebrate their Bnot Mitzvah as a group at TKAE.

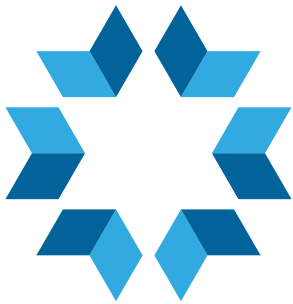
